- Policies:** Great Hearts Online student-athletes will need to select what [Great Hearts brick-and-mortar academy](#) they will be playing for. They will play for that school for the duration of their middle school years unless they later enroll at a different brick-and-mortar academy or request a transfer if circumstances arise that require a change. The academy for which they are playing does not necessarily need to be the one closest to their domicile. In all athletic transfer situations, the sending Athletic Director, the receiving Athletic Director, and the Network Director of Athletics will all be involved and in communication with each other when this request is made by a family.

Interested Great Hearts Online families will need to contact the Athletic Director from their desired school to indicate their wishes to play by January 18. The Network Director of Athletics will keep record of all Great Hearts Online student-athletes for any questions that may arise from Great Hearts Online Administration or from Great Hearts Athletic Directors.

All Great Hearts Online student-athletes and their families will need to follow all Great Hearts' and the school's athletic rules and regulations. All Great Hearts Online student-athletes will be considered regular student-athletes. They will have to register, pay athletic fees, and follow all rules, regulations, and guidelines set forth by both Great Hearts and the school for which they are playing for, including but not limited to academic and attendance standards.
